**MINUTES**

I. Call to Order, Pledge of Allegiance, and Roll Call

President Thaler called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Town Clerk Pro Tem Barbara Molina called the roll: Michael Hill, Susan Thaler, Robert Jurovaty, James McCormick, Barbara Molina, Karen Wiggins, and John Skrandel were present.

II. Items for Discussion

a. Discussion on state statutes on golf cart operation originated from information provided on request by Town Marshal Hal Hutchins. Issues included the need for an ordinance legalizing the use of golf carts in the Town of Briny Breezes, compliance with state statutes as to crossing State Road A1A, width of sidewalks adjacent to the state road, properly equipped golf carts, golf carts vs. "street-legal golf carts"/low-speed vehicles, and speed of golf carts.

III. Public Comments related to golf cart issues only

Comments were made by residents who emphasized the need for safe golf cart use in Briny Breezes. Comment was received as to the need for golf carts to slow down and to have headlights after dark. Comment was received requesting that the Town research the cost of widening the sidewalks east of State Road A1A and research whether changing the direction of any of the one-way private roads would eliminate the need to widen the sidewalks.
