**MINUTES**

- I. Call to Order and Roll Call: President Thaler called the workshop to order. Present: Aldermen; Christina Adams, Chick Behringer, Bob Jurovaty, Jim McCormick, and Sue Thaler, and Mayor Jack Lee; Captain Chris Yannuzzi and Jeffrey Livergood.
- II. Additions, Withdrawals, Deferrals, and Arrangement of Agenda Items: None
- III. Ex-Parte Communications: None
- IV. Items for Council Discussion ó Discussion on FDOT response on Golf Cart Crossing/Sidewalk Widening:
  - President Thaler mentioned that funds have been budgeted for a few years for the Golf Cart Crossing/Sidewalk Widening. Depending on outcome additional funds may be needed. If the funds are not utilized, they would be returned.
  - After review of FDOT comments by Mr. Jeffrey Livergood , Director of Public Works and Engineering for the City of Boynton Beach; Mr. Livergood sent FDOT a response on our behalf, requesting permission to install turnarounds.
  - FDOT responded that they will not approve the turnarounds at this time. After much discussion with FDOT, FDOT District Traffic Engineering will re review.
  - President Thaler explained along with Jeff Livergood if FDOT does not approve turnarounds, we may need to bring the sidewalk and other areas up to current standards. This means possible widening of the sidewalk, landscaping work, and ADA updated Standards.
  - There was discussion on making Cordova a two way street.
  - Jeff Livergood stated turnouts are the best option, or we can leave things the way they are, but reminded golf carts canø cross A1A
  - Tom Oglesby mentioned the Sidewalk issue should be discussed at Briny Breezes, Corporation at their next meeting.
  - There was a discussion about adding tactile warning signage.
  - Discussion on Golf Carts; how many golf carts are in the community and how many golf carts are road legal, in addition to insurance questions. Bob Jurovaty reported that Street legal Golf carts can cost \$10,000.00 plus insurance.
  - There may be a need for a Golf Cart Ordinance.
