

**TOWN COUNCIL OF BRINY BREEZES
SPECIAL MEETING AT TOWN HALL
MONDAY, MAY 4, 2015, 1:00 P.M.**

MINUTES

- VIII. Items for Council Action at Public Hearing:**
 - a. First reading of Ordinance 2-2015 Providing for the Use of Golf Carts on the Streets and Roadways of the Town of Briny Breezes**
Discussion of the Ordinance included the age of allowed drivers, concluding that golf cart drivers must be licensed. The consensus was that speed limit of carts should be 5 mph on sidewalks and 15 mph on roads unless otherwise posted. Golf carts shall be allowed on sidewalks adjacent to state roads, but not municipal roads, and shall give right of way to pedestrians. A **MOTION** was made and seconded (Jurovaty/McCormick) to pass Ordinance 2-2015, with changes as discussed, on first reading. Motion passed three to one, Alderman Molina opposed.
